

DECISIONS TAKEN AT THE CKC-AAA EIGHTEENTH ANNUAL CONVENTION, AT RALEIGH, NC ON 19 JULY, 2014

We, the members of the Christ the King College Onitsha Alumni Association In America, Inc. (CKC-AAA), a 501 (c) 3 non-profit, tax-exempt entity, meeting at our Eighteenth Annual Convention and General Assembly, in Raleigh ,NC 18-20 July 2014.

1. **Having considered** the 2014 Report on the State of CKC-AAA, and the Implementation of the 1999 *Los Angeles Plan of Action* and the 2004 *Washington DC Follow-Up Plan of Action* submitted jointly by the President of CKC-AAA and the Chairmen of the Finance and Endowment Fund and the Project Implementation and Management Committees, and the 2013-2014 State of the School Report submitted by the Principal C.K.C. Onitsha, Rev. Fr. Dr. Charles Okwumuo;

2. **Reaffirms** our commitment to the motto of Christ the King College, Onitsha: *Bonitas, Disciplina Scientia* and to keeping our collective aspiration that CKC and its alumni must remain, *Primus Inter Pares*, (First Among Equals); and that by **“Education the Summum Bonum of knowledge and Progress in the Future”** the alumni of the college placed in eminent and lofty leadership positions in Nigeria and in the Diaspora are capable of offering inspiring, purposeful and exemplary leadership and service in all facets of private and public service;

3. **Reiterates** our commitment to making CKC Onitsha the best among its peer legacy schools by giving back and through our continued collaboration with the school’s proprietor, His Grace Archbishop Valerian M. Okeke, the Archbishop of the Metropolitan Archdiocese of Onitsha and the Proprietor Christ the King College, Onitsha and other stakeholders;

4. Pay tribute to and commend

- a. The founders, builders, custodians, and departed and presents alumni, staff and students of our great Alma Mater;
- b. **Mr. Fidelis Atuegbu**, President of CKC-AAA and his Executive Committee colleagues for their selfless service with a view to upholding our honoured legacy;
- c. **HE Gov. of Anambra State of Nigeria**, the 2014 Convention and Charles Okoye Memorial Keynote Speaker;
- d. Our hosts, CKC-AAA North Carolina Chapter for their very warm and exceptional hospitality;
- e. CKC Onitsha alumni resident in the Americas, who have contributed generously to the **“CKC Revitalization/ Diamond Jubilee Trust Fund”**; and supported on-going revitalization efforts at CKC Onitsha;

5. Elect and

- a. **Elect** the following Officers for the 2014-2016 Fiscal Year;
President: Fidelis Atuegbu; Vice President: Larry Ozoh
General Secretary: Felix Ezejiofo; Financial Secretary: Chuma Ozowalu
Treasurer: Eugene Agbimson; Public Relations Officer: Patrick Ikeagu
Agent: Patrick Ejike; Chaplain: Rev. Ugo Arinze

6. Approves

- a. That CKC-AAA Executives carry out their mandate pursuant to the Los Angeles Plan of Action, the Washington DC Follow-Up Plan of Action, 2014 Convention Mission Statement and these decisions pending the availability of funds;
- b. The disbursement during **FY 2015 of Three Hundred thousand Naira, (\$300,000.00)** as follows:
 - Two Million One Hundred Thousand Naira (**N100,000.00**) to service CKC-AAA Annual Motivational Award for the “Best Tutor” and “Best Student” in 2013; and
 - One Hundred Thousand Naira (**N100, 000.00**) to service the “School Principal’s’ Unforeseen Emergency Expense Fund for 2015; and
 - One Hundred Thousand Naira (**N100, 000.00**) in equal share, as a one-time university academic scholarship to the four (4) most deserving graduating seniors in 2015;

7. **Confirms** the holding of the 19th Annual Convention and General Assembly of CKC-AAA in California in July 2015, and therefore, decides to meet one year from now, on **24-26 July 2015** in San Francisco, CA.

8. **Requests** CKC-AAA Executives to continue discharging the mandate given to them by selflessly serving the Association; and to report to the 2014 Convention in progress made on implementing the 2004 Washington DC Follow-Up Plan of Action and particularly, the mandate in paragraph 6, 7, and 8 above. **[END]**
