Since its founding, the college has actively maintained its relationship with the Catholic Church despite being appropriated by the Anambra State Government in 1973 and temporarily renamed **Herrey High School**. The school reverted to the Catholic Mission on 1 January 2009. The College provides equal educational opportunity for all qualified students without regard to race, religion, creed, color, age, and physical disability, national or ethnic origin. **Christ the King College Onitsha**, Nigeria has a present enrolment of 2,700 students in both the Junior Secondary School (JSS) and Senior Secondary School (SSS) levels (Grades 7- 12).
